

Protection of human subjects



Per NIH policy, <u>human subjects protection training</u> is required every three years for all key personnel who are involved in the design or conduct of NIH-funded human subjects research. To satisfy this requirement, only good clinical practice (GCP) is acceptable

(https://grants.nih.gov/policy/clinical-trials/good-clinical-training.htm). CITI certificate is only acceptable if it specifically says it is for GCP training (CITI offers many different courses). Online training is available in a variety of languages, free of charge, through several organizations, including but not limited to the following online courses: Global Health Training Centre (https://globalhealthtrainingcentre.tghn.org/ich-good-clinical-practice/); Training and Resources in Research Ethics Evaluation (https://elearning.trree.org/).The RCC and NIH do not require or endorse any specific training program.
